Interview to Mr Bruno Felicetti, director of the Local Tourist Board of Fiemme Valley

1) How did you start your career in tourism?

Mr Felicetti says that he attended a post-diploma course in tourism, then he started working in a hotel as a receptionist, afterwards he started working for a local tour operator that was managing the Nordic skiing world Championship for 1991. As a receptionist he had to cope with different tasks, he had to talk with the guests, answer telephone calls and manage reservations.

All this was very interesting but it was also a real challenge; at that time hotels did not have the facilities they have today, you can think for example that only few rooms had a bathroom en suite and that there were only 5 fax machines in the whole valley.

In the 90s the first associations of hotels were created with the aim of promoting and selling hotel products and services.

Mr Felicetti joined the association called Fiemme Reservation on 1st May 1992 (Labour Day), afterwards he worked in the marketing sector; he was entrusted with the managing of the 2003 World Championship of Nordic Skiing.

At present Mr Felicetti holds the position of chief of the local Tourist board of the Fiemme Valley.
